EXPERIENCE HENDRIX

Henri returned to major stages with the Experience Hendrix Tour, performing 24 shows in 2024 and another 27 performances in 2025. These appearances further strengthened his connection to live audiences and his place within a musical legacy that continues to inspire generations.
