Artist biography

Lenny Pojarov is a singer, songwriter and pianist born in Kyrgyzstan whose musical development continued in Germany. She began formal classical piano lessons at six, later adding guitar and ballet to her studies. After moving to Germany, she started vocal training. Her school choir introduced her to musical theatre, swing and gospel before she entered professional pop performance.

Her live work has taken her to clubs in Paris, London and Ibiza, as well as hotel venues in Shanghai and Monaco. Her biography also records a performance at Berlin's Olympic Stadium and participation in television productions including X Factor and Come Dine With Me. These experiences span intimate entertainment settings, major venues and television.

Lenny describes her musical direction through a blend of neo-soul and pop. As a songwriter, she moves between gentler, emotionally focused material and upbeat songs built for singing along and dancing. Piano and vocals remain central to that identity, supported by a background that reaches beyond a single style.

Her releases include the debut EP DRAMA 2.0, issued in January 2014; When I See You, the Color Festival tour anthem released in July 2015; and the single Phoenix, released in November 2016. Together, these recordings document the development of her original music alongside her work as a live performer.

With experience as a vocalist, instrumentalist and entertainer, Lenny brings her own songs and a contemporary performance approach to the stage. Her career combines early classical study, the influence of choir and vocal training, and international work in clubs, hotels and larger productions.
