Brazilian-born vocalist, pianist, arranger and musical director Beatriz Malnic is internationally respected for her refined interpretations of bossa nova, samba, Brazilian popular music and the Great American Songbook.

A graduate of the University of São Paulo with a bachelor's degree in music, Beatriz began her international career as a member of the touring ensemble of renowned Brazilian artist Toquinho. During five years with the group, she performed around the world and participated in numerous recordings and television productions.

After moving to the United States, Beatriz quickly became an in-demand performer, studio vocalist, educator, arranger and choir director. Her sophisticated voice, impeccable pitch and elegant phrasing have led to collaborations with celebrated musicians including Chico Buarque, Al Di Meola, Roberto Menescal, Nestor Torres, Duduka da Fonseca, Mike Renzi and Mike Orta.

She has recorded five albums and one DVD. Several projects, including Bossa n' Blues and Chico Buarque by Beatriz Malnic, received Brazilian International Press Awards, while her artistry has also been recognized with honours for outstanding vocal and bossa nova performances.

As co-founder and musical director of the acclaimed all-female ensemble Brazilian Voices, Beatriz has created numerous vocal arrangements and helped guide the group to international recognition. Graceful, expressive and musically sophisticated, she offers an authentic Brazilian performance filled with warmth, elegance and world-class artistry.
